## ***Global Programme for the Management of AnGR: Objectives and Milestones***

- ***Global Programme Implementation: 2000-2007*** (approved in 1996 within a 10 years Mid-term Plan)
  - ***Create Global Awareness on the importance of assessing AnGR***
  - ***Invite countries to prepare Country Reports (7 March 2001)***
  - ***Train AnGR professionals world-wide (2001-2004)***
  - ***Assist member states in the preparation of Country Reports (2001-2005)***
  - ***Promote sub-regional, regional and global co-operation (2002-2006)***



## *Milestones of the Programme*

- *Prepare Special Priority Actions Report (2004)*
- *Prepare the 1<sup>st</sup> Report on SoW-AnGR (2005)*
- *Initiate the 1<sup>st</sup> International Technical Conference on AnGR (2004-2006)*
- *Discuss on the Need for the Preparation of International Treaty on AnGR (2004-...)*
- *Continued Technical and Financial support to countries and regions*
- *Continued national, regional and global communication for understanding AnGR*



## ***Status of the State of the World's-AnGR Report***

- ⦿ ***Significant progress has been achieved in the process***
- ⦿ ***The dominant activities have been related to the preparation of Country Reports***
- ⦿ ***Guidelines were developed and translated into five official languages and Russian***



## *Progress on SoW-AnGR*

- *189 countries were invited to participate in the SoW-AnGR*
- *165 countries, incl. Belarus, Russia, Ukraine, Moldova accepted to participate and submit Country Reports*



## *Training Programme*

- *Global Orientation and Training Workshop*
- *14 Regional Training Workshops*  
*396 professionals from 181 countries*



# ***Follow-Up Activities***

***16 follow-up sub-regional

- ⊙ ***to support and facilitate preparation of CR in the countries***
- ⊙ ***to enable interactions and exchange among countries in the region***

- ⊙ *Financial support to more than 110 developing and in-transition countries through the partnerships (WAAP, SPC)*

- ◎ *Renewed efforts for Sub-Regional and Regional Cooperation*
  - *Caucasians working together: Tbilisi Workshop for AnGR AgroWeb, 2004 and for National Follow-up: January 2005*
  - *East European Cooperation for better communication, ERFPP and the Minsk Workshop, March 2005*
- ◎ *Setting up Regional and Sub-Regional Focal Points*
  - *Caribbean Network and Sub-Regional FP, based in Jamaica*
  - *East African RFP, based in Kenya, March 2005*
  - *South-West Asian RFP, based in Bangladesh*



## ***Follow-Up Activities in 2005***

- ⊙ *Initiation of more policy dialogues*
  - *on national and regional priorities in every continents*
  - *follow-up actions at national and regional level*
- ⊙ *Follow-up mechanism in FAO*
  - *Capacity building courses, project formulation support*
- ⊙ *Working with Donor countries, identify resources*
  - *The Netherlands, Finland, France, USA, Norway, Nordic GeneBank, UNDP, UNEP, GEF and FAO*
- ⊙ *Special International Team created to write the 1<sup>st</sup> Report on SoW-Angr*



## ***FAO works with Global and Regional Partners***

- ⊙ A network of regional technical facilitators assisting with in-country training and preparation of CRs*
- ⊙ Regional facilitators provided guidance and feedback to National Consultative Committees and National Coordinators and assisted in the review of draft CRs*
- ⊙ New function of Regional Facilitators: Promote regional coordination and set up information network*
