## The CIARD RING

### a Routemap to Information Nodes and Gateways (RING)

sharing information on agricultural research and innovation for development (ARD)







### Availability is not enough!

Users have to locate and search several sources that provide partial answers to complex questions







#### Solution: new value added services

Value added information services that

search, filter, aggregate, and collate information from various sources

acting as a **gateway** and an **orientation service** 

that support and enable the development of other integrated value-added services





### **Solution: value added services**

outputs?







#### **Global Directories**

- Distributed architectures minimize duplication in information storage and flow and improve reliability
- Distributed storage and maintenance of digital objects (e.g. document, organization, project, event)
- Metadata accessible as XML/RDF records using international standards
- Centralized directories provide access to the distributed sources through a community registry/ies





### **Services in the RING: examples**

- Services will be part of the RING if they provide:
  - XML exports of information using agreed metadata sets
  - documents participating in the new AGRIS or in the Open Archive Initiative (OAI)
  - RSS feeds
  - etc...

#### AGRIS

- AGRIS Database and Search Engine: webbased bibliographic database and search engine
- Database currently has over 2.5 million references to documents of various kinds
- Data currently being provided from over 40
  "AGRIS Resource Centres" worldwide
- 200,000 users per month 300% increase in 2008 with many referrals from Google



#### **AGRIS Tools**

Tools used in preparation of input to, or extraction of data from, the AGRIS database:

- AGRIS Application Profile (AP): open standard created for description, exchange and retrieval of metadata of agricultural Document-Like Information Objects (DLIOs)
- AGRIS Subject Categories: set of categories of agricultural objects (e.g. documents and projects), created for the AGRIS database
- **AGRIS Serials List**: list of scientific journals and serial publications covered in the AGRIS database.
- WebAGRIS: complete, multilingual Web-based system for distributed data input, processing and dissemination



### **AGRIS Access/Support**

- AGRIS Website (<u>http://www.fao.org/agris/</u>): provides access to the database/search engine and tools as above. Various communities are linked to the website from the *"DGroups"* platform with discussion ongoing on the following topics: (a) AGRIS, (b) AGRIS AP, (c) WebAGRIS.
- AGRIS Secretariat: FAO unit, currently the Knowledge Exchange and Capacity Building Division, responsible for maintaining the AGRIS database, tools, and website

#### Common standards: News: RSS Events: AgEvent AP

- Owners
  - generate and maintain "source" feed(s)
  - tag single items in the feed using keywords (tags) for subjects (e.g. e-agriculture, avian influenza) or countries
- Users:
  - search/filter based on criteria using tags
  - aggregate by harvesting from different repositories using tags
